

Paddle Pool Rules

- No food or beverages allowed by the pool area
- Before using the Wag Central pool, all dogs must have a swim evaluation, to be scheduled through Pet Exec or front desk with Wag Central Swim Coach. This evaluation includes: fitting swim vest or head collar, and instruction on a long lead - provided by Wag Central
- All dogs should use designated potty areas prior to entering the Paddle Pool
- All dogs are required to rinse off in self wash prior to pool use
- All dogs should enter and exit the pool one at a time
- Each swim session is in 20 minute intervals to prevent exhaustion
- Maximum capacity for dogs in the pool is 4 at all times (all sizes)
- Pool is for dogs only, no humans allowed in the pool or on the pool deck
- Only two parents are allowed to be in pool area, never on the pool deck
- Females in heat are not able to use the pool
- **All required vaccinations must be current:** Rabies, Bordetella, DHPP, Leptospirosis, Canine Influenza Bivalent, a negative fecal withing the past 6 months testing for ova, parasites, and Giardia.
- Dogs that are observed coughing excessively, sneezing, have eye or nose discharge, diarrhea, vomiting, or extreme lethargy, will not be allowed in the pool
- Any dogs who have had surgery within the last year require written sign off from their vet
- No topicals, creams, perfumes, or lotions allowed on the dog 48 hours before pool use
- Dogs must not eat 4 hours before swimming
- Cancellation Policy: Minimum of 24 hour notice or you will be charged in full
- A \$250 sanitation cleaning fee will be charged for any dog that has fecal or vomiting incidents within the pool
